




ABOUT THE COVER

Southampton Arts partners with **Saugeen District Senior School** each year by asking their art students to design a cover for our class catalog. This year we received 11 entries from the grade 11 and 12 students, and through our social media, a 'People's Choice' campaign was held to choose the winner for the cover of our 2023 catalog. The winning cover was created by **Eshal Shahid**. The piece is titled ***The Art of the Ocean***.

Eshal captures the fragile beauty of marine life. Vibrant and beaming with life, the ocean is the cornerstone of the Earth's life support system. It holds most of the life on Earth. However, its beauty and fragility are suffering because of the greatest mass bleaching event in history. The goal for this piece is to shine light on the issue that is so often disregarded. Eshal draws parallels between this theme and the artist community. There are so many shining artists who have created outstanding pieces, but just like the coral reefs, they can be overlooked without support and programming in places such as the Southampton Art School. Having a strong and supportive arts community adds to the vibrant rural environment that we want to foster in Saugeen Shores.

We would like to thank all the students that submitted artwork for our 2023 cover. All of the work was truly amazing! Crossed Structure Bookbinding with Kari Bronaugh

Learn to make a spellbinding cover structure invented by the Spanish Bookbinder, Carmencho Arregui! The text block sewing is partially hidden by a two-piece soft cover with straps that cross over the spine. Students will use a basic French link stitch for sewing the text block, which creates a hard-wearing, secure text block which is very useful in an exposed binding. Students can choose either soft leather or suede or a beautiful heavyweight handmade paper for the cover material. The inside pages will be 98lb/160 GSM acid-free Mixed Media Canson Paper, which works well for marker, pastel, pencil, acrylic, watercolour, charcoal, or pen and ink.

Scratch art is a unique art form using scratchboard or pre-inked paper. The surface has a layer of white clay topped with another layer of black India Ink. The original design is lightly scratched into the black ink surface using very delicate tools, concentrating on lights and darks until the desired effect is achieved. The Blue Heron image has many scratches, allowing precise detail and control of lines, enabling the artist to bring the piece to life. The Blue Heron can then be painted with watercolours to achieve a finished work of art!






