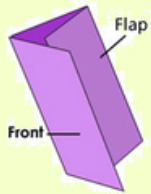
Art on Wheels

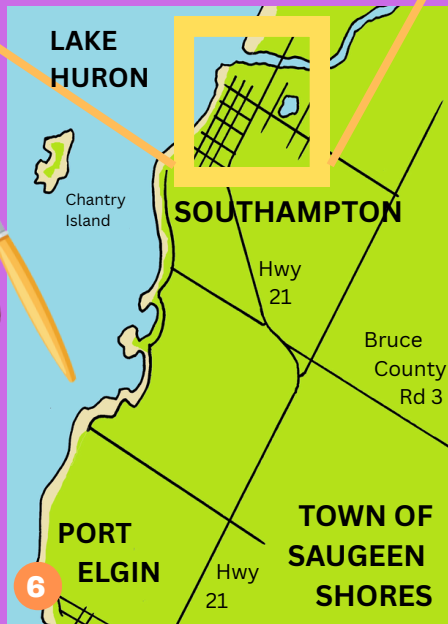
